The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 signed on February 17th by President Obama provides a tax credit for qualifying energy-efficient home improvements including windows and doors through 2010. **Homeowners can receive a tax credit equal to 30% of their investment, up to \$1,500.**

In order to receive the tax credit, the window or door must achieve a .30 or lower U-factor and .30 or lower Solar Heat Gain Coefficient. This is more stringent than the current ENERGY STAR® specifications. Peachtree is proud to offer an unequaled breadth of products that qualify for the tax credit.
